

THE GENERAL SUPERIOR'S COMMUNIQUÉ
concerning the opportunity
for the members of the Association of Marian Helpers
of the Congregation of the Marian Fathers
to gain a plenary indulgence

I wish to communicate that on March 30, 2012, the Apostolic Penitentiary granted to the members of the Association of Marian Helpers of the Congregation of Marian Fathers *in perpetuum* ([Prot. No 1281/11/I](#)) the opportunity to gain on May 18th – the liturgical commemoration of Blessed Fr. Stanislaus Papczyński – a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Holy Communion, prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father), while making, at least privately, a renewal of their pledge of faithfulness to the Statutes of the Association of Marian Helpers.

I also wish to remind the Association of Marian Helpers members that under the rescript of the Apostolic Penitentiary of May 16, 1968, they are granted *in perpetuum* the opportunity to gain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions on the following days:

- on the day of joining the Association;
- on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary;
- on the Feast of the Nativity of Our Lord;
- on the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the B.V.M.;
- on the Solemnity of Assumption of the B.V.M.;
- on the Solemnity of St. Joseph, the Spouse of the B.V.M.

Please make this communiqué, along with the text of the appropriate decree, known to the interested parties.
